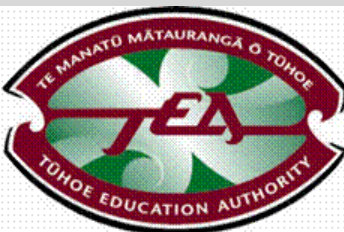

### TOL broadband is coming

Tūhoe Online (TOL) is now building the broadband network into Taneatua, Ruatoki, Waimana, Kutarere and Waiotaha. Building the network will involve erecting 6 meter high towers (pictured right) on hilltops that have clear line of site between each other and Pūtauki. On these towers the WIFI broadband equipment will be attached.

Te Whai o Te Kotahi are currently practising for the Aussie kapa haka regionals to be held in Melbourne shortly. The winning team will represent Australia at the next Te Matatini National Kapa Haka competition in 2009 - kia kaha e te whanau!

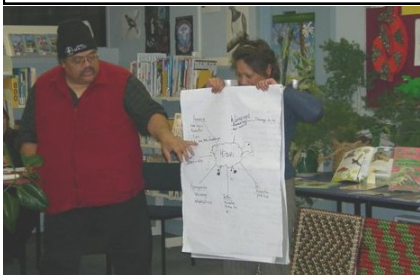

- A draft business plan has been developed to progress the vision for TWMOT in 2008 - 2010

“He taurangi waitohu kia tū one ngā hapu ki roto i Te Whare Maire o Tūhoe”.

**MANA PLAN (POWER)** Recommended for power users who want to transfer substantial quantities of data or use interactive applications and games. The mana plan is for our Kura and high users.

**12 MONTH MINIMUM PLAN** We spread some of the costs of the install kit and set-up support over time. As a result, plans are for a 12 month contract term. If you choose to terminate the contract within the 12 month period, we will invoice you for the remainder of that contract period.
